



New Build of Temporary Hire Facilities

Between February 2009 and April 2010 Bradley-Mason were engaged by two tool hire consortiums (which collectively included Speedy Hire, APlant, BSS Group, Lavendon Access Services and Hewden Plant Hire) to help design and project manage the creation of two separate tool hire facilities located on the London 2012 Olympic Park construction site. Both projects had to be fully operational facilities designed for short term use before decommissioning prior to the 2012 Games.

Bradley-Mason were able to collate the various client requirements and devise a cohesive scheme that met the overall brief.

With a strong focus on sustainable development to meet Olympic Development Authority (ODA) requirements, the schemes incorporated rain water harvesting, photo voltaic solar panels and ground source heat pumps.

Designs also fully maximised the space available, ensured contaminated ground was not disturbed and waste was minimised.
